DURHAM— A partnership campaign between Reinvestment Partners and the East Durham Children's Initiative aims to get money back in the community by encouraging local residents to file their tax returns.

Reinvestment Partners, which provides free federal and state filing tax services to any individual who typically makes under \$54,000 a year through its Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program, held a community outreach event Friday morning to warn against the consequences of any improperly filed form and the benefits of the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC).
